Order of Canada

The Order of Canada was established in 1967 by Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II. The Order of Canada is the cornerstone of the Canadian Honours System and recognizes outstanding achievement, dedication to the community, and service to the nation. The three-tiered order is accorded to those who exemplify the order's Latin motto, *desiderantes meliorem patriam*, meaning "they desire a better country".



Companions of the Order of Canada (post-nominals: CC) have demonstrated the highest degree of merit to Canada and humanity, on either the national or international scene. Up to 15 Companions are appointed annually, with an imposed limit of 165 living Companions at any given time, not including those appointed as extraordinary Companions or in an honorary capacity. Substantive members are the only regular citizens who are empowered to administer the Canadian Oath of Citizenship.

Order of Military Merit

The Order of Military Merit was established in 1972. It recognizes distinctive merit and exceptional service displayed by the men and women of the Canadian Armed Forces, both Regular and Reserve. Many have demonstrated dedication and devotion beyond the call of duty, and the Order honours them for their commitment to Canada. Her Majesty Queen Elizabeth II is the Order's Sovereign, the governor general is its Chancellor and a Commander, and the chief of the Defence Staff is its Principal Commander. The insignias presented remain the property of the Crown. All inductees are entitled to petition the Chief Herald of Canada for personal armorial bearings, should they not already possess any, and may have the escutcheon (shield) of their arms encircled with a blue ribbon bearing the order's motto, *officium ante commodum*, meaning, "service before self".

Most Honourable Order of the Bath

The Most Honourable Order of the Bath is a British order of chivalry founded by George I in 1725. The name derives from the medieval ceremony for creating a knight, which involved bathing (as a symbol of purification) as one of its elements. Members of the Order wear elaborate costumes on important occasions (such as its quadrennial installation ceremonies and coronations), which vary by rank: Knights and Dames Grand Cross wear the mantle, made of crimson satin lined with white taffeta. On the left side is a representation of the star. The mantle is bound with two large tassels; the hat is made of black velvet and includes an upright plume of feathers; the collar is made of gold and weighs 30 troy ounces (933 g). It consists of depictions of nine imperial crowns and eight sets of flowers (roses for England, thistles for Scotland and shamrocks for Ireland), connected by seventeen silver knots. The Order has many ranks and division that have evolved over time. The following are those that have been awarded to members of The Royal Regiment of Canadian Artillery.

Knights Grand Cross, Most Honourable Order of the Bath (post-nominals: GCB) entitled to receive heraldic supporters. They may, furthermore, encircle their arms with a depiction of the circlet (a red circle bearing the motto) and the collar; the former is shown either outside or on top of the latter. Knights and Dames Commanders and Companions may display the circlet, but not the collar, around their arms. The badge is depicted suspended from the collar or circlet.

Most Distinguished Order of St Michael and St George

The Most Distinguished Order of St Michael and St George is a British order of chivalry founded in 1818 by King George IV while Prince Regent acting for his father, King George III. It is awarded to men and women who hold high office or who render extraordinary or important non-military service in a foreign country, and can also be conferred for important or loyal service in relation to foreign and Commonwealth affairs. It is named in honour of two military saints, St Michael and St George. The Order's motto is *Auspicium melioris ævi* "Token of a better age".

Order of the Companions of Honour (post-nominals: CH) is an order of the Commonwealth realms founded in 1917 by King George V as a reward for outstanding achievements. The first recipients of the order were all decorated for services in connection with the First World War. It is now described as being awarded for having a major contribution to the arts, science, medicine, or government lasting over a long period of time.

Most Excellent Order of the British Empire

The Most Excellent Order of the British Empire is a British order of chivalry, rewarding contributions to the arts and sciences, work with charitable and welfare organizations, and public service outside the civil service. It was established in 1917 by King George V and comprises five classes across both civil and military divisions, with the most senior two classes making the recipient either a knight if male or dame if female.
