



Jean Chrétien was the Prime Minister followed by Paul Martin in 2003 and Stephan Harper in 2006. Quebec votes against separation in the 1980 Quebec referendum. The War on Terror and War in Afghanistan began after the September 11 attacks in 2001. The International Criminal Court was formed in 2002. A United States-led coalition invaded Iraq, and the Iraq War led to the end of Saddam Hussein's rule as

Iraqi President and the Ba'ath Party in Iraq.

Al-Qaeda and affiliated Islamist militant groups performed terrorist acts throughout the decade. These acts

included the 2002 Bali bombings in Bali, Indonesia, 2004 Madrid train bombings, 7/7 London bombings in 2005, and the Mumbai attacks related to al-Qaeda in 2008. In addition, there was the 2001 anthrax attacks in the United States, 2004 Beslan school hostage crisis in Russia, The European Union expanded its sanctions amid Iran's failure to comply with its transparency obligations under the Nuclear Non-Proliferation Treaty and United Nations resolutions.

The Second Congo War (1998–2003) – took place largely in the Democratic Republic of the Congo. The widest interstate war in modern African history, it directly involved nine African nations, as well as about twenty armed groups, and earned the epithet of "Africa's World War" and the "Great War of Africa." An estimated 3.8 million people died, mostly from starvation and disease brought about by the deadliest conflict since World War II. Russia invaded Georgia in 2008 in response to Georgian aggression towards civilians and attack on South Ossetia. Both Russia and Georgia were condemned internationally for their actions. The Second Chechen War (1999–2000) – the war was launched by the Russian Federation on August 26, 1999, in response to the invasion of Dagestan and the Russian apartment bombings, which were blamed on the Chechens. During the war Russian forces largely recaptured the separatist region of Chechnya. War in Darfur (2003–2009) – an armed conflict in the Darfur region of western Sudan. Millions of people were displaced from their homes during the conflict. There are various estimates on the number of human casualties with claims from roughly 19,500 civilians to over 400,000.

Mexican Drug War (2006–present) – an armed conflict fought between rival drug cartels and government forces in Mexico.

The greatest loss of life due to natural disaster came from the 2004 Indian Ocean earthquake, which caused a tsunami that killed around one quarter-million people and displaced well over a million others. The Sri Lankan Civil War (1983–2009) came to an end after the government defeated the Liberation Tigers of Tamil Eelam. Over 80,000 people were killed during the course of the conflict

Hurricane Katrina flooded nearly the entire city of New Orleans. The resulting political fallout was severely damaging to the George W. Bush administration because of its perceived failure to act promptly and effectively.

2000 overthrow of Slobodan Milošević in the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia – after Slobodan Milošević was accused by opposition figures of winning the 2000 election through electoral fraud, mass protests led by the opposition movement Otpor! pressure Slobodan Milošević to resign. Milošević was later arrested in 2001 and sent to the Hague to face war crimes charges for his alleged involvement in war crimes of the Yugoslav Wars.

Vic Stevenson was the Honorary Lieutenant-Colonel with Bill Wickett the Honorary Colonel. Peter Veuger was appointed Honorary Lieutenant-Colonel in 2004 with John Brownlee-Baker taking over as Honorary Colonel that same year.





VR-61 Islanders







Honorary Colonel John Brownlee-Baker CD



Honourary Colonel John Brownlee-Baker enlisted in the Royal Artillery as a Boy soldier in 1958. In 1960 to 3rd Regiment Royal Horse Artillery as a gun number. The next 14 years saw his rapid promotion through the ranks until, in 1974, he was promoted to Warrant Officer Class I and appointed Regimental Sergeant Major of 19 Field Regiment, Royal Artillery at 32, becoming the youngest Gunner Regimental

Sergeant Major since World War 2. Two years later he was posted to the Royal School of Artillery as Garrison Sergeant-Major. In 1978 he left the British Army. During his 20 years with the Royal Horse Artillery and the Royal Artillery he saw service in North and East Africa, Middle and Far East, Rhine Army, both southern and northern flanks of NATO, and in the United Kingdom. He was awarded his Long Service Medal in 1976 and holds bars to the General Service Medal for Radfan, South Arabia and Northern Ireland. He was awarded the Commander in Chief's Commendation during operations in the Radfan Mountains in 1964.

He emigrated to Canada in 1979 and, after a short break from soldiering, joined the 15th Field Artillery Regiment, RCA as a Master Warrant Officer in 1981. A move to Ontario saw him transfer to 10 Field Battery in St. Catharines, and his commission to the rank of Captain as a Troop Commander. In 1983 he returned to Vancouver and 15th Field Artillery Regiment, RCA. Honourary Colonel Brownlee-Baker assumed command of the 15th Field Artillery Regiment in 1991, a position he held until 1996. He was appointed Honourary Colonel in April 2004.
